QKR OUR PREFERRED PAYMENT METHOD

The new Qkr (pronounced 'quicker') app is now live for families of students at Thornlie Primary School.

Qkr by MasterCard can be downloaded for free from Apple's app store for iPhones (for I pads download the iPhone app) or from Google Play for Android phones and tablets.

After downloading the app and registering, simply select Thornlie primary School from 'Nearby Locations' on Qkr or type **thornlie** after tapping the magnifying glass in the top right of the home screen on Qkr.

You can pay for School Contributions and Charges, Sports activities and Excursions. Other items will be available for payment on Qkr over time, so download it today and take a look at our school on Qkr.

Please refer to the attached flyer that will give you step by step instructions on how to download Qkr and register your child/ren so you are ready to make payments. Additional information is available on our website.

Alternatively monies can still be received via EFTPOS, Cash or Direct Deposit into the schools bank account.

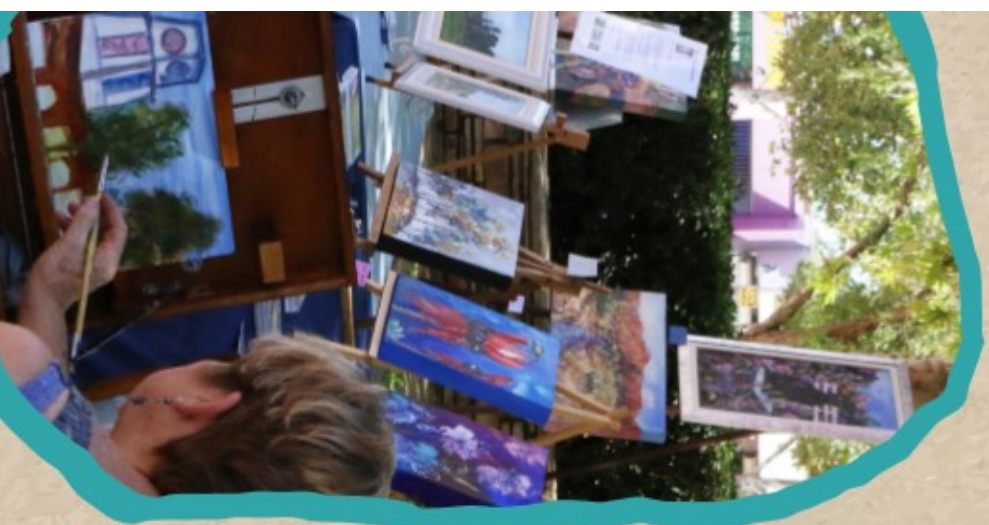

The students made bird masks and we used the Talk for Writing strategy to role play and do actions about the story.

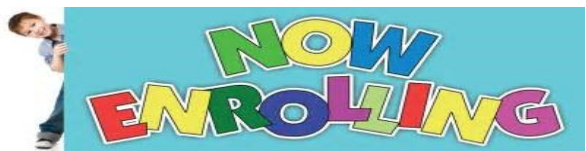
Doing the actions and role playing has helped the students to gain a deeper understanding of the text. The students were really enthusiastic to complete reading and writing activities

If you want your child to be successful at school –attendance DOES matter

STUDENT HEALTH

During Terms 2 and 3 we often see an increase in student absence due to respiratory (colds/flu) and gastroenteritis infections. Whilst it is often difficult to prevent transmission, every effort should be made to minimise the spread of infection. The WA Department of Health Communicable Disease Guidelines outline the following best practices:

- ◆ Students/Staff should stay home in the early stages of illness as at this stage they can be infectious and shed the virus, bacteria or parasite through coughing, sneezing, contaminating surfaces and personal contact.
- ◆ Students/Staff who have had gastroenteritis should not return to school until they have been symptom free for at least 24 hours.
- ◆ Parents should seek medical advice if their child has ongoing symptoms of illness.

To minimise the spread of viruses, children should be encouraged to cover their coughs and sneezes with tissue and blow their nose regularly. Tissues should be disposed of properly and hands washed regularly.

Absences from school need to be explained. This can be achieved by sending a note with the student upon their return to school, contacting the office on 9459 4333 or sending a text message (SMS to 0437 881 842)

Please make certain to advise the school of any recent phone number changes.
