Your teacher will make contact through Connect on day 1 to provide you with a timetable to start online learning.</li> <li>A relief teacher will be employed to teach face-to-face the students who remain in the classroom.</li> </ul> <p><b>Scenario 3: TEACHER IS ISOLATING AND <u>NOT</u> WELL ENOUGH TO TEACH (SYMPTOMATIC)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the teacher is isolating and not well, a relief teacher will be employed to teach the students who remain in the classroom and/or students who are learning from home.</li> <li>The relief teacher will liaise with the Administration Team to ensure online learning is available through Connect.</li> </ul>
<b>Hard copy learning package</b>	In the event of a whole school closure with no advance warning, it will not be possible to send home learning packages and parents will need to access on line learning for their child/ren.	Families who don't have access to online learning are to arrange for their child/rens learning package/s to be picked up from a designated point at the school or the learning packages can be mailed home. However, when they are well enough to resume online learning please contact the classroom teacher and inform them of the change.
